



Drugs and Illegal Substances Policy

Statement: Streetwise Community Circus is committed to promoting the health, welfare and safety of all its members and participants and recognises the potential harm the misuse of drugs (please see below for definition) may cause: With this in mind the Board and Management of SCC CIC therefore commit to the implementation of the following policy in all areas and levels of activity within the organisation.

For the purposes of this policy the term “drugs” refers to :-

“Drugs or artificial stimulants, legal or illegal used for recreational purposes”

- No individual will knowingly introduce any drugs into a workshop
- No individual shall participate in the workshop while under the influence of any drug.
- No individual shall knowingly promote the use of drugs in a workshop
- No member of staff in the employ of SCC.CIC should knowingly promote or advocate the use of drugs in the presence of minors.

In addition all staff members prescribed medication that may in any way affect their performance while carrying out the duties of their employment must disclose this information to the administrator prior to commencement of work in line with SCC’s Health & Safety Policy
